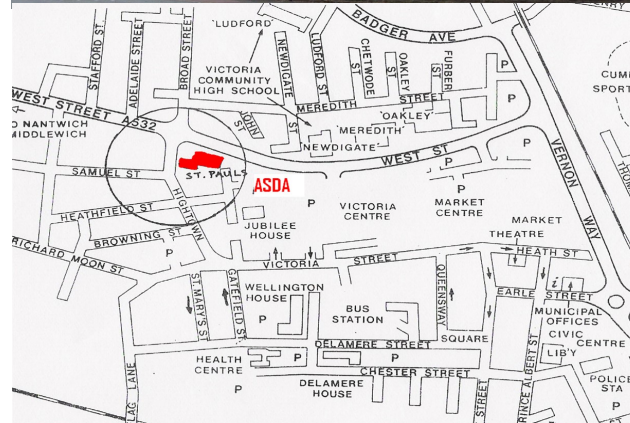

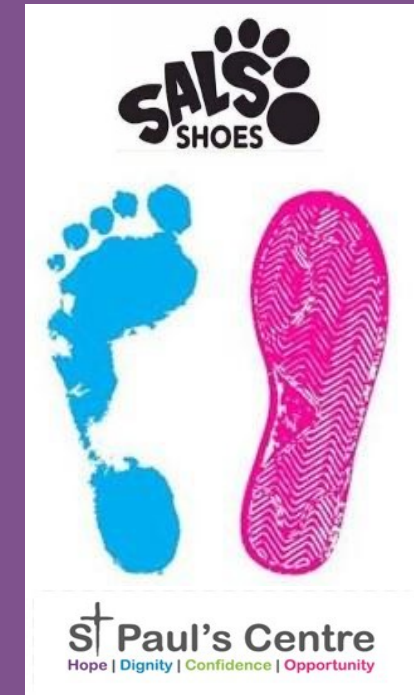

## Who is the footwear for?

Sal's Shoes @ St Paul's aims to provide good quality footwear, a mix of re-used and new, free of charge for children under the age of 18 years old.

Children who are referred to Sal's Shoes will be eligible for 4 pairs of shoes within a 12 month period.

Families can access this service by referral only.



## Who can refer a family in need?

Any person who is supporting the family who is able to assess the genuine need for the provision of footwear. For example, social workers, family support workers, mental health team, school's workers and health workers.

A referral form will be emailed which must be completed by the referring agent.
