This week in Nursery we have made friendship bracelets.



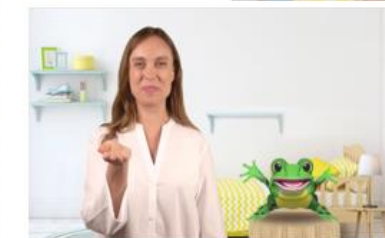
