At Gainsborough we know the importance of working in partnerships with parents and carers and research shows that it can lead to better academic and social outcomes for children.


This is why we offer lots of opportunities for parents and carers to attend events in school, giving you the opportunity to strengthen this partnership.

Please can you enjoy an autumnal walk together. Look out for the signs of Autumn. We would be grateful for any conkers, pine cones and acorns you might find.

Year 6

In science, Year 6 are learning about evolution and inheritance. This week our focus has been on the work of Charles Darwin and the observations he made whilst on the Galapagos Islands. First we read about his observations regarding the tortoises and their shell shape. We then closley observed images of the finches who live on the islands and discussed differences that we could see. After that, using our 'Agree, Build, Challenge' oracy skills, we suggested reasons for their different beak shapes. Finally, we conducted an experiment using different 'beaks' and food types to see how differing beaks would affect the food a bird would be able to eat.
