Dear Parents/Carers,

Here at Gainsborough, we teach the children regularly about internet safety and how to protect themselves when online, including when using their mobile phones.

Children learn the importance of being kind to others when online, as well as never sharing any personal information. They also learn about digital footprints and that they should always tell a trusted adult if they see anything online that worries or upsets them.

Let us all speak KIND WORDS to each other in person. to others. online.

It is important for parents and carers to talk to children about internet safety at home too. Having this conversation helps to prepare your child from an early age, so they can safely explore the internet and know who to speak to if things go wrong.

It's also important to listen to your child and give them a chance to talk about what they're experiencing online, what apps and sites they use and who they're talking to.

You could try making it part of a daily conversation, like you would about school. This can help your child feel relaxed, and means that if they do have any worries about online safety, they're more likely to talk to you about it.

Here is a reminder of the age limits of various popular apps that many children are accessing from their mobile phones and tablets.

Year 1 have been using dark and light shades of colour to create winter landscapes in the style of Kandinsky.







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
