

As part of our World Book Day celebrations, Year 6 composed some short pieces of music - using tuned and untuned percussion instruments - that could be used in the film adaptations of Harry Potter. The children had to think really carefully about the mood they wished to create and the musical elements (pitch, dynamics, texture and tempo) that they would use to create this. The children used a mixture of formal notation and graphic scoring to record their ideas. Finally, they had the opportunity to perform their composition and record it.
